JUDGEMENT

ISHTIAQ AHMED, MEMBER : This order is meant to dispose all the appeals Nos. 2957 and 2958(R)CS-2012, as the same involve common questions of facts and law.

2. Both the appellants Sajid Matloob and Abdul Ghafoor Javaid have sought the relief of upgradation from BPS-14 to BPS-16, on the basis of identical judgment, in appeals Nos. 209,212,217(R)CS/200 passed by this Tribunal and upheld by Hon'ble Apex Court. It is alleged that till 2007, Senior Auditors and Stenographers were placed alongwith Assistants in same BPS. Now, Senior Auditors and Stenographers have surged to BPS-16 and Assistants are still languishing in BS-14. KPK Government has recently enhanced the scale of Assistants to 16. The respondents are averse to the genuine demand of the appellants.
