OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: UPGRADATION OF THE POSTS OF RESEARCH ASSISTANT/DATA PROCESSING SUPERVISOR / DATA CONTROL ASSISTANT (BS-14) AND DATA CODER (BS-12) TO (BS-16) IN PCB

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Information Technology's UO. NO.4(1)/2004-Dev, dated 30.12.2004 and OM of same number dated 5.4.2005 on the above subject and to state that Establishment Division agrees to the up-gradation of posts of Data Control Assistant /Data Processing Supervisor/Research Assistant from (BS-14) to (BS-16) under the designation of Data Processing Assistant in Pakistan Computer Bureau subject to concurrence of the Finance Division, amendment in the Recruitment Rules and filling of the up-graded posts in prescribed manner.

2. Establishment Division does not however, agree to the proposed merger of the post of Data Coder (BS-12) with the above mentioned posts and its subsequent up-gradation to (BS-16) , because in accordance with recruitment rules notified by PCB vide their SRO NO.226(KE) /89,dated 11.12.1989, the post of Data Coder (BS-12) is filled in 100% by promotion from the post of Key Punch Operator (BS-10) for which the prescribed qualification for initial appointment is Intermediate. Further, 25% of the posts of Data Control Assistant / Data Processing Supervisor / Research assistant (BS-14) are reserved for promotion from Data Coder (BS-12) with 03 years service as Data Coder. As such the post of Data Coder (BS-12) is not similar to the posts of Data Control Assistant /Data Processing Supervisor/Research Assistant (BS-14) in Pakistan Computer Bureau.


